With reference to the above cited subject, Keeping in view the prevailing situation of Covid-19, if the colleges want to conduct the workshop physically, Colleges should follow the Rules & Regulations of Government of India & Maharashtra Govt. prescribed to observe during COVID-19 pandemic, in addition Kindly follow the guidelines of COVID-19 issued by local authorities.

For organizing workshop, College has to follow the instructions, which are mentioned in Academic Notification No.13/2016 along with the instructions, which are mentioned below during conducting 3 days Basic Research Methodology Workshop for teaching faculty and Post graduate students of the College.

#### Guidelines for 03 days Basic Research Methodology Workshop:

- Following health measure are to be followed to reduce the risk of COVID

  19 by all faculty & participants.
   Workshop should be conducted in large Auditorium with,
  - Physical distancing of at least 6 feet to be followed as far as feasible:
  - ii) Use of face cover/masks to be made mandatory.
  - Frequent hand washing with soap (for at least 40-60 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty.
  - Use of alcohol-based hand sanitizers (for at least 20 seconds) can be done wherever feasible.

- The workshop can be conducted over 3 full days or 4-6 half days, as suitable. It should be completed within ONE WEEK.
- 3) A minimum of 18 hours course duration is compulsory. Out of 18 hours, institution may include topics of their choice upto a maximum of 3 hours. Remaning 15 hours must be from the MUHS Curriculum. Alternately, the full 18 hour Programme may be as per MUHS curriculum.
- 4) The recommended number of participants for the workshop will be kept only 30. The participants would be regular teaching faculty of colleges and Post graduate students of your college. The participants will be on deputation during the period of workshop.
- Participant must complete Online Registration process on University website (www.muhs.ac.in).
- 6) Each participants should preferably join/ logging in separately. All personal logins may please add the college name first followed by participants name. Participants must wear name badges at all time having serial numbers written on them. As per participant's list provided to the observer.
- Pretest and Posttest must be conducted for every workshop.
- 8) An observer may be appointed by the University for the workshop. Observer will be present onsite physically or observe online.
  - a) The Observer if nominated by the University would be paid TA/DA and honoranium of Rs. 500/- per day by the Organizer. The observer will submit a report of the workshop to the IMETTT, Dept., of the University.
  - b) If online, the observer needs to make sure that the college has sufficient resources to provide live audio-video stream to the observer. This should be pre-tested by observer before the actual workshop.




Day 2 - 12th July,2022


